<u>Maths</u>

This term, we will learn all about the number 3- to be able to recognise the numeral and subitise up to 3 objects. Subitise means that children are able to look at a group of objects and realise how many there are without counting such as spots on a dice when rolled. Children will learn how to count objects, saying one number for each object and begin to match quantity to the correct numeral.

Additionally, children will learn about length-long and short and will continue to develop understanding of shape and pattern.

Spring Term

This term, children will continue to work within phase 1 of Letters and Sounds focusing on aspects 4, 5 and 6. This includes children listening to initial sounds, joining in with repetitive stories and rhymes as well as hearing and listening to their own voice sounds. Children will begin to hear the initial sounds in their own name.



Physical development

Physical development is very important in Pre-school, as developing these skills help to support children's future writing skills.

Children will continue to build strength in their arm muscles as they take part in Squiggle while you wiggle and will begin to use these marks to represent writing during continuous provision.

Some children will begin to write letters from their name.



In P.E, children will explore topics:

This term we are focusing on developing a well being approach. We will be supporting children to talk about and learn how to manage their emotions through activities, songs and meditation as well as providing them with a calm space.
