This term we will be looking at:


Shape- recognising and identifying a range of 2D shapes.

Fractions-identifying a whole of an amount and to a name a half as one of two equal parts.

Position and direction- describing direction using a range of vocabulary such as forwards and backwards and to describe turns using full turn and half turn.

Multiplication- Recognising equal groups of a quantity using the language of 'groups of' or 'lots of.'

<u>Year 1</u> <u>Spring Term</u>



English

We will be teaching the following objectives through the text 'The Jolly Postman.'

- -Writing full sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- -Using the conjunction 'and' in-between words and clauses.
- -Using the prefix 'un' and the suffix 'ed' to change the tense of words.
- -Sequencing events of the story in the correct order.
- -Writing a letter/postcard using the text as a stimulus.

History

This term we will be looking at settlements and employment in the local area. This will include looking at the Mills and Mines in the local area. As part of this topic, we will be visiting Spinners Mill to learn more about the History of Cotton and the role Leigh played within this industry.

We will then move onto look at Queen Victoria and will be making links back to our first History topic of the year the Royal Family.



Year 1 Spring Term

<u>P.E.</u>

This term we will be looking gymnastics and invasion games.

<u>Geography</u>

Our Geography topic will start after the Feb half term where we be looking at the seaside. We are hoping to get in a visit to the seaside as well weather permitting.



Computing

This term we will be looking at programming. For this the children will use the Beebots. The children will learn directional language and use this to create an algorithm for the Beebots to follow.

During the second half of the term, we will move onto creating media.

This term we will be looking at online safety and well-being.

Art

After February half term we will be focusing on painting during our art topics. Our end product will be linked to the seaside.

Science

The Science topics we will study are:

Changes - We have continued our work on seasonal change and have looked at Winter this term. The children will talk about what months winter occurs, how the weather changes, how our clothes change and what happens to the days.

Animal - During this topic, our focus will be on Humans. The children will name body parts, learn about their jobs/functions and carry out an investigation linked to our learning.
