#### Maths

This term we will be looking at: Number and Place Value: Recapping Autumn Term and focusing on rounding to the nearest 10,100 and 100.
Addition and Subtraction: Round and adjust, adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers.
Shape – Angles: Recognising, comparing and ordering different types of angles.
Position and Direction: Using co-ordinates in the first quadrant.
Multiplication and Division: To use short multiplication and short division with 2 and 3 digit numbers.
Fractions: Recapping Autumn term focusing on improper fractions, mixed number fractions and equivalents.
Decimals – Linked to Money: Adding, subtracting, dividing numbers to 2 decimal places.
Measure: converting between different units of measure such as kg and L.
Statistics: Reading scales of 25, 250, 1000 with equal parts and present data in tables/graphs.
