Children are able to access Bug Club through tablets or Ipads with their passwords. Texts will be allocated to your child to read. This does not replace the reading books but gives you the option and flexibility to read in different ways. Please contact your class teacher if you have difficulty accessing Bug Club so that any issues can be resolved quickly.
